1.0 What are Experiences and why are they important?

Most hotels and Airbnb's focus on outcome (a quiet bed for the night or a place to crash). What makes VC different is that we also offer **Experiences**. These can range from simple pleasures such as the VC Spa, dressing up in fancy dress for dinner, creating arts & crafts in The Cow Shed or making Coconut Cocktails in the dedicated bar. I am 19 and I remember doing all of these things while I was growing up here!

2.0 There are three types of Experiences:

2.1 In-House Experience

Bad weather? Or simply wanting to have a relaxed day at VC? Enter this on the Experience Hub and cook on our Italian Pizza Oven, use one of our over forty board and card games or indulge in The VC Spa. You're also invited to read the family written book about the untold Story of Wimbledon Common. Or watch a half an hour film we made (which was shown at the Odeon) about the unique sporting history of the Common.

2.2 Garden Experiences

Perfect Experiences for a sunny day! The Coconut Bar at the end of the garden! Crazy Mud Golf or having a fire in the Natural Fire Pit.

There three additional garden areas are charged together for an additional flat rate of £70 per night.

The **Coconut Bar** has a sofa and is filled with music and sports memorabilia. It comes with cocktail apparatus, wine, beer and shot glasses.

The **Gardener** is a music, yoga/meditation room. It's equipped with musical instruments and yoga videos of different experience levels.

The **Cow Shed** is a fully equipped arts and crafts centre and is a place for kids to unleash their inherent creativity.

The Kids Crafts Bench: these crafts will create a physical memory you can take home with you to always remember your stay at VC. You can also get a VC Certificate from Max.

We have a sports cupboard. The equipment in here can be used in the garden or on the Wimbledon Common playing pitches which are only a two-minute walk away. These areas are available for booking even after you have checked in. Please contact Max on +447914542358 on WhatsApp for more detail

2.3 Adventure Experiences

Adventure Experiences are ones outside of the VC, in Wimbledon Common, Richmond Park to name just two locations. They require some preparation but offer so much to explore and inspire. My childhood favourite was playing cricket with my dad and brother on **Wimbledon Common**, only a two-minute walk from VC. Other examples include hiring bikes in **Richmond Park** and cycling around the Royal Park.

For adults, there are many exciting experiences, ranging from seeing **Soho** (known for its historic nightlife) to **Kew Gardens**; 300 acres of garden containing over 68,000 floras.

VC is overflowing with invisible **historical sights: Wimbledon's Football Club's first ground** is a 5-minute walk from VC on Wimbledon Common. Their current ground is only a 15-minute drive away. A relatively unknown fact is that Wimbledon Common is where many global sports were formed; **tennis and rugby** to name a few. There is a family made film (that was shown in the local Odeon cinema) and another book we wrote on this project is at VC for you to read. Wimbledon Tennis Championship is the oldest tennis championship in the world and the **All England Tennis Club** is located on the other side of Wimbledon Common.

3.0 The Experience Hub

The way to access these experiences is to use the **Experience Hub;** more specifically the **175+ Experiences** on the VC Website. This was built by my younger brother. Using this you can filter for the length, location and if you want your experience to be child or adult centric. Also on the VC Website is our **VC Travel Guide**.
